What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> John 14:3 Who is this promise for?</p>	<p>Make a rocket and shoot it into the sky. Discuss that Jesus ascended into heaven and will return one day.</p>	<p><b>ROMANS 8:31B</b> Is there anything that separates us from Jesus?</p>	<p>Until Jesus returns, we are His witnesses. Pray for reliance on the Holy Spirit and then share the good news of Jesus with others.</p>	<p>Each family member shares a prayer request with the family. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Romans 8:26 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 3</b> -----</p> <p>The Holy Spirit lives in followers of Jesus. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Acts 2:38 How do we receive the Holy Spirit?</p>	<p>Ask believers in the family to share about a time the Holy Spirit convicted them of sin.</p>	<p><b>ROMANS 8:31B</b> How does this verse give you hope?</p>	<p>Ask believers in the family to share about a time the Holy Spirit brought to mind a scripture to guide them.</p>	<p>Go for a walk outside and talk about God's love for us. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Isaiah 41:10 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 4</b> -----</p> <p>God is for us when the world is not. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> John 16:33 When we face trouble, what can we be sure of?</p>	<p>Build a block tower. With each block, list how God is for us. Talk about how God's love is eternal.</p>	<p><b>ROMANS 8:31B</b> How do we know God is really for us?</p>	<p>Draw a heart and write ways you can "take heart" this week by knowing that God is for us even when the world is not.</p>	<p>Share how you have each changed in the last year. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Luke 23:26-24:12 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
